- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
- 2 1. Page 2, line 1: before that line insert:
- 3 “SECTION 1c. 118.258 (title) and (1) of the statutes are repealed.
- 4 SECTION 1e. 118.258 (2) of the statutes is renumbered 120.12 (29) (c) and
- 5 amended to read:
- 6 120.12 (29) (c) Annually, ~~if the school board adopts rules under sub. (1), it~~
- 7 shall provide each pupil enrolled in the school district with a copy of the rules policy
- 8 under par. (a).”.
- 9 2. Page 2, line 8: delete “118.258,” and substitute “118.258;”.
- 10 3. Page 2, line 19: after “device” insert “, other than a school district-issued
- 11 wireless communication device,”.
- 12 4. Page 3, line 16: delete lines 16 and 17.

- 1 **5.** Page 3, line 17: after that line insert:
- 2 “(d) 1. By no later than October 1, 2026, submit a copy of the policy under par.
- 3 (a), or if applicable, a policy that is more restrictive than what is required under this
- 4 subsection, to the office of school safety in the department of justice.
- 5 2. By no later than October 1, 2027, and each October 1 thereafter, notify the
- 6 office of school safety in the department of justice of whether changes were made to
- 7 the policy submitted under this paragraph in the previous school year, and if
- 8 changes were made, submit the updated policy to the office of school safety in the
- 9 department of justice.
- 10 (e) Nothing in this subsection prohibits a school board from adopting a policy
- 11 relating to the use or possession of wireless communication devices by pupils that is
- 12 more restrictive than what is required under this subsection.”.
